### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Maybank Tiger Peso Bond Feeder Fund primarily aims to provide capital appreciation by investing in a single collective investment scheme, called the Target Fund. As a feeder fund, 90% of its assets shall be invested in the Target Fund which is the Sun Life of Canada Prosperity Bond Fund. The Target Fund is primarily invested in government and high quality corporate debt securities. The remaining portion of the assets (maximum 10%) will be invested and reinvested by the Trustee in investment outlets allowed under the regulations of the BSP.

### CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The Maybank Tiger Peso Bond Feeder Fund is suitable for clients with at least a moderate risk profile and medium-term investment horizon. This Fund is for clients who desire potential returns higher than traditional bank deposits.

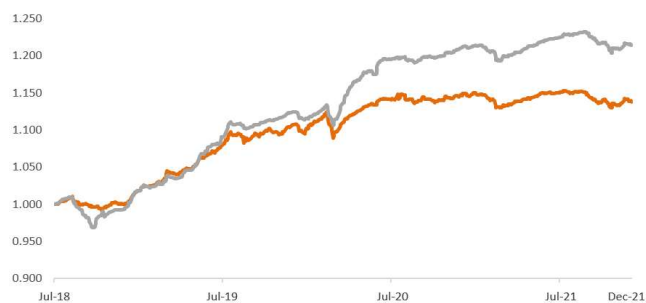

**NAVPU GRAPH**

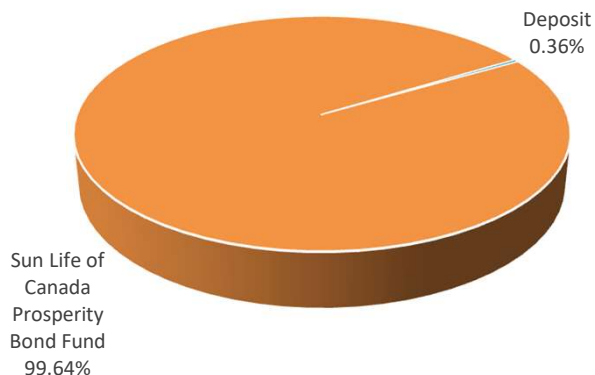

**OUTLOOK**

The Bureau of Treasury successfully raised Php360 billion from its latest offering of 5.5-year Retail Treasury Bonds (RTBs) last December. Heavy selling pressure though was seen as the new RTB 5-14 started trading. With coupon at 4.625%, the security was initially lifted at 4.25% or 37.5 bps lower than its coupon. The newly-issued RTB ended the year at 4.45%. This bond issuance helped raise enough cash for the BTR to reject bids at auction. Both 10yr and 7yr bond reissuances were rejected during the month of December despite the bids being in line with secondary market levels.

Moreover, choppy trading sessions were seen towards the end of the year due to low volume during the holiday season resulting to wide bid-offer spreads. The BTR's announcement of a Php200 billion borrowing plan for January 2022 from Php70 billion in December 2021 also spooked the market further, as it contradicts their initial statement of a lower borrowing plan for 2022.
